## Next Generation Emergency Services Market

- Transitioning to an Internet-based communication networks has created the need for updating legacy 9-1-1 services.
- Traditional 9-1-1 systems were limited to voice-based technologies, but advancements in mobile device and networking technologies have opened the door for advanced features.
- One key issue with the transition to IP-based emergency services is identifying the location of the device requesting assistance. Legacy 9-1-1 systems contain a location associated with each telephone number. With approximately 70% of calls being made from mobile devices, next generation systems require a more advanced way of obtaining location information.
- The claimed technology in this portfolio covers methods and systems for providing location information from an IP enabled device. The claims are applicable to mobile devices, networks and vehicular communication systems.
